Information clause on processing of data of

Housing Forum 2024 Participants'

- The co-administrators of the personal data are the Habitat for Humanity Poland Foundation with its registered office in Warsaw, ul. - 2. Personal data will be processed for the purpose of participation in the Housing Forum 2024, in connection with your application via the form on the basis of your consent (Article 6(1)(a) RODO). In addition, your image will be processed for the purpose of publicizing and processing in photos or videos taken during the event on the website and on the Joint Administrators' social media profiles, as well as during live broadcasts, based on your consent, i.e., Article 6(1)(a) of the DPA;
- 3. Recipients of personal data will be: personnel of the Joint Administrators and entities providing services to the Joint Administrators: IT, telecommunications necessary for the performance of tasks.
- 4. Data may be transferred outside the European Economic Area and thus processed also before entities operating, among others, in the United States of America. The Administrator has taken care to use only suppliers that provide guarantees of a high level of personal data protection. The Administrator ensures that the transfer of data outside the EEA is carried out with adequate safeguards, i.e. on the basis of an appropriate agreement between the Administrator and such entity containing standard contractual clauses adopted by the European Commission (the content of the agreement is available from the Administrator) or on the basis of a decision on the adequate level of protection taken by the European Commission.

a. In connection with the transfer of data to the United States, guarantees of a high degree of protection of personal data derive in particular from the participation of providers in the "EU-US Data Privacy Framework" program, established pursuant to the Commission (EU) decision of July 10, 2023 finding an adequate degree of protection for personal data provided by the so-called "EU-US Data Privacy Framework".

- 5. Personal data will be processed no longer than until the withdrawal of consent or the exhaustion of the purpose for which the data was obtained. This period may be extended by the period necessary to defend against possible claims, the expiration of data storage deadlines indicated by law.
- 6. You are entitled to:

a. access to your personal data, their rectification, erasure or restriction of processing, as well as the right to data portability;

b. withdraw your consent at any time to rodo@habitat.pl. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the dispatch of marketing content made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

c. in the case where the data is processed based on the legitimate interests of the Administrator - the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data
